

Frequently Asked Questions on WIE Track

Q.1. Why to publish in IEEE ANTS WIE and not in the main track of IEEE ANTS?

Ans. The WIE paper has the same paper review process as of the main track. Also, papers will be available in IEEE explore similar to main track papers without any identifier tag of 'WIE', i.e., in the citation of the published paper, WIE tag will not be explicitly visible. Hence, there is no difference in the papers published in the two tracks- main and WIE.

Q2. What are the benefits of submitting papers in the WIE track?

Ans. The paper submission and acceptance procedures are the same. In addition, this will promote participation of women engineers and increase their presence in the conference. Women authors will get a chance to interact with each other, network, promote each other professionally now and later. Students and faculty from different locations can also grab the opportunity of collaboration. It will also help in industrial connects. There will also be invited talks from women leaders in academia and industry that will inspire women faculty. Women can also discuss typical challenges faced by them and have tips on overcoming those to become successful.

Q3. Should all the authors of a paper be females?

Ans. No. One of the authors should be a woman and the first author should preferably be a woman.

Q4. Can all the authors attend the conference?

Ans. Yes, but the woman author should necessarily participate and present.

Q5. Do we need to pay extra amount for the registration in WIE?

Ans. No

Ans. The process of accommodation will be similar to the main conference.

Q7. Do we need to present the paper in WIE or will it be presented in front of all the authors like in main track?
